DISC2004 on Deepwater Petroleum Systems Held In Chennai

Due to the persistent efforts of SPG-India, the Distinguished Instructor's Short Course (DISC) 2004 of SEG was organized by SPG-Chennai Chapter at Savera Hotel, Chennai on 2nd August, 2004. Dr. Paul Weimer, Professor of Geology, University of Colorado and Director of Energy and Minerals Studies Centre delivered an excellent presentation on “**Petroleum systems of deep water settings**“. Shri A. Saha, Chief, Geophysical Services, ONGC and President-SPG India inaugurated the event.

Around 40 Geoscientists from various work centers of ONGC, Reliance, Cairn Energy, Gujarat State Petroleum Corporation, DGH and students from Andhra and Cochin Universities participated in the programme.

The topics covered by Prof. Paul included Sequence Stratigraphy, depositional models, direct hydrocarbon indicators, turbidite system, cyclisity and development of deep water system, carbonate deep water fans, vertically stacked and offset stacked channels and mass transport complex of deep water systems. He also presented the emerging global scenario of challenges and key to future success in deep water exploration.
