The lecture high- lighted the usage of seismic attribute in Reservoir characterization Dr. Chopra emphasized that the success of any project depends upon the kind of data sets available and one should not deliberately compromise with data. Both types of parameters, static and dynamic, of reservoir should be carefully studied by the Geoscientists before arriving in conclusion. Now-a-days the reservoir characterization is so much complex that one can't ignore any types of data.

This presentation explores the many categories of seismic attributes created in the past years and their general use in an interpretation workflow. Neural Analysis of seismic attributes

has been shown to be effective in understanding variations in unconventional resource geological deposition, finding “sweet spots” and understanding complex structural and fracture trends

Lastly Dr. Chopra concluded his lecture with the quotation 'if you cannot do great things, do small things in a great way'
