


SPG WEBSITE STATISTICS FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY TO JUNE 2025



The history of monthly activity for the SPG, India website over the first six months of 2025, based on the categories shown on the color bar above. A notable increase in activity is seen in January, which may be attributed to the posting of the December 2024 issue of GEOHORIZONS, which was expected as mentioned in the website statistics published in the last issue. Trou Aux Cerfs (Murr's Volcano). It is a dormant, crater lake, cinder cone volcano with a well-defined cone and crater. It is 605 m high and located in Curepipe, Mauritius. The crater is 300 to 350 m in diameter and is 80 m deep. The crater was formed less than 2 million years ago in the second phase of volcanic activity that created Mauritius.
