One day workshop on “Soft Skill and Technical Project Writing” was organized for the students of Petroleum Engineering on September, 15, 2015 as a part of MIT SPG Student Chapter activities. Shri Makarand Pandit, a specialist in the field of Technical writing and soft skills conducted this workshop, which was sponsored by Sri Mandar Pathak, an alumnus of MIT-Pune. About 60 students of Petroleum Engineering (3rd year), attended the program.

Shri P.B. Jadhav, Faculty Advisor, Student Chapter stressed importance of soft skills and also technical writing during his introductory speech.

Initially Sri. Mandar Pathak gave brief introduction on why he wanted the students to understand the finer aspects of soft skills including writing of resume and preparation for

interview along with importance of Technical Project Writing as a career for graduating engineers.

Shri Makarand Pandit initiated his workshop with small stories on

how incorrect resume can lead to non-selection in spite of extreme good academic profile. He asked students to write and read their resume and explained the art of writing. He also gave tips for interview and conducted mock interviews in the afternoon. After lunch, he focused on the aspect of technical writing and stressed importance of this emerging area as career for engineering graduates students lack initiative because of their rural background.
