

Call for Papers for Jaipur-2015

Technical Programme Committee for “Jaipur 2015” invites original technical contributions, in the form of well written, illustrative Expanded Abstracts of not more than six A4 pages inclusive of figures, tables and pictures, on a range of topics indicated in this call. Authors are requested to submit their papers online at society's website www.spgindia.org. Please do see next section for the guidelines for preparation and submission of technical papers. The submissions shall be reviewed and acceptance shall be communicated well in advance to authors. All accepted papers will be distributed on CD-ROM as conference proceedings.

Technical Programme Committee will only consider the expanded abstracts received by 15th July, 2015.

The authors can opt for either oral or poster presentation of their paper and the same will be kept in consideration while finalising the session plans. However, the final decision rests with Technical Program Committee.

Oral presentations will be organised into various technical sessions. These presentations are PC based, using common desktop-presentation tools like MS-PowerPoint, Acrobat Reader and are pre-loaded centrally.

Poster sessions will be held concurrently with oral sessions in a separate area during designated hours. A single digital/ display board (Height 138 cm, Width 98 cm) will be provided for each poster. The minimum letter size is 10 mm. Use of multi-colour is recommended.

Guidelines for Submission of Expanded Abstracts

The technical paper written in English, should be a compressed, informative, accurate representation of the original work. It should be relevant to one of topics of technical program as indicated below.

3. Depth Imaging, Velocity modelling and Anisotropy
4. Interpretation and Visualization of Geodata

7. Reservoir Geophysics & Borehole Geophysics
8. Geomechanics and Seismic Geomechanics

9. Near Surface Geophysics
10. Non seismic methods of exploration
11. Emerging Technologies in Unconventional Exploration and exploitation
12. Quantitative Geophysics
13. Seismic inversion and joint inversion
14. Economics of Exploration & Production and Challenges thereof
15. Geophysics and Global economic scenario
16. Geophysical Research-practical and theoretical- way forward

All Technical Papers will be published as received and no resetting of material is envisaged.

The technical paper must follow the general scheme given hereunder. Papers not conforming to the desired format may be rejected.

- Title of Paper (not longer than 235 characters) in bold and sentence case
- Name of all the authors (not more than 7) with an asterisk on the name of presenting author/speaker
- Current affiliation (employer) of all the authors and country in which they are working
- E-mail address of the speaker/corresponding author
- Abstract / Summary
- Introduction
- Details of the study arranged under different headings / sub-headings
- Conclusions
- Acknowledgments (optional)
- References

The total length of the paper should not exceed six A4 size pages. The preferred font size is 10 point, normal weight, Times New Roman. Figures and Tables should be placed within the text at desired location in the manuscript. A downloadable template for Technical Paper is hosted at SPG website, which can be used by the authors to prepare their paper in proper format.

Authors should submit the soft copy of their paper in MS Word/pdf format. It is to be noted that:

- (i) The paper needs to be uploaded on the SPG website www.spgindia.org, where a link has been created for this purpose.
- (ii) In case of any difficulty in uploading the paper, the author can contact technical committee by email to techcomspg@gmail.com

- (iii) Abstracts submitted through fax will not be considered.
(iv) In normal case, authors need not send the hard copy of the paper. However, authors from ONGC Ltd (India) are required to submit the hard copy also, along with ONGC checklist as per their organisation's policy.

Technical Papers accepted for presentation will be published in the form of proceedings of the conference, a soft copy of which will form part of delegate's kit. Only properly written Technical Papers that are in line with the instructions given above will be considered.

It is implied that authors of the accepted papers are transferring copyright in respect of the technical paper in favour of SPG, India.
